

2010 Agricultural Market

Summer events

The weekly farmers' market is dedicated entirely to agriculture, the centerpiece of our rural character and our heritage of traditions and culture.

This year the dates are:

- Every Monday (year-round) from 8.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. in Piazza della Repubblica, located in the historical center
- Every Wednesday (from 9 June to 29 September 2010) from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. in Piazzetta Casabianca

In the agricultural markets, consumers can find, in addition to seasonal fruits and vegetables, cold meats and cheeses, flowers, also local products like DOP cheese, *barena* honey from the salt marsh, DOC wines from Piave and IGT ones from the Veneto, jams and vegetables preserved in olive, black cabbage and coriander, dandelion, not to mention products derived from organic agriculture, typical cold cuts and some products, considered to be endangered, like the indigenous Verduzzo of Motta wine and the aged cheese *asiago stravecchio*.

The agricultural market thus adds value to and promotes typical local products, as well as offering consumers the possibility of spending less on food on the basis of a "smaller carbon footprint" resulting from the reduced distances between the production and sale points, and the absence of intermediate passage of the products, and, finally, a payment method that also helps improve the environment by reducing air pollution due to transportation of goods.
